There are numerous lake water stands throughout the Park and we ask that you use these for your lawns, gardens, and all other outdoor needs.

Our sewage treatment system suffered mechanical damage from things like Q-tips, solid plastic applicators from female sanitary products, lots of grease too. Please put only bio-degradable materials through your drains and toilets.

Although 10% of your lease costs are allocated to the supply and maintenance of your services, the hydro portion far exceeds normal usage (\$150-\$175 per lot).
